## IMPORTANT NOTE:

When buying native plants make sure they are pure natives. The tag should have the *common name* and the *genus/species name* such as Purple Cone Flower (common name), Echinacea Purpurea (genus/species name).

Named cultivars such as Purple Cone Flower "Pow-Wow Wild Berry" may no longer have the qualities needed by pollinators.
